## FORT HUNTER LIGGETT MICROGRID RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY

Media are invited to cover Fort Hunter Liggett's historic microgrid ribbon cutting ceremony on September 17 at 10 a.m. Senior Army and partnering agency leaders available for interviews at event.

Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) continues to lead the way in the Army's energy resilience as the first-ever military installation with a microgrid implementation using only renewable sources such as photovoltaic (PV) generation and battery storage. The Army Reserve-funded installation is very close to becoming a Net Zero installation and is on track to achieve target year of 2030, which is ahead of the Executive Order 14057 (Catalyzing Clean Energy Industries and Jobs Through Federal Sustainability) goal of 2045. **READ FULL STORY:** <u>https://www.army.mil/article/278992</u>
