City Hall Remodel — Facility Access Changes Effective Immediately

PASO ROBLES, CA — As part of the ongoing City Hall renovation, new public access routes will take effect today. These adjustments are intended to allow public access to services while navigating visitors around construction. The remodel project is described in full here: www.prcity.com/1264/City-Hall-Remodel.

What's changing

- Access to the Paso Robles Library and public restrooms will now be through the double doors facing 11th Street.
- Access to the temporary City Hall public service counter will be through the double doors
 accessed from the parking lot on 10th Street.
- There will be no through-access in the City Hall/Library lobby during construction.
- Effective Friday, November 21, 2025, portions of the City Hall parking lot will be closed due to construction activity. Refer to the attached site plan for more information.

These changes help keep public services safely accessible while construction is underway by clearly directing visitors to the correct entry points and reducing mixing of public and construction traffic.

All telephone and email contacts for departments remain unchanged, and services remain uninterrupted.

The City appreciates the patience and cooperation of residents, staff, and visitors during this transition. The remodel is a long-term investment to modernize the facility, improve safety and accessibility, and better serve the community. 


Figure 1 City Hall Remodel - Construction Site Plan
