**City of Paso Robles Annual Creeks to Coast Clean-Up Day Event  
September 20, 2025**

PASO ROBLES, CA –

The City of Paso Robles is calling on volunteers to participate in the annual **Creeks to Coast Cleanup on Saturday, September 20, 2025**. This community-wide event will focus on protecting local waterways, including the Salinas River and neighborhood creeks, from trash and pollution that ultimately flow to the coast.

Volunteers of all ages are invited to join us at **Larry Moore Park** (155 Riverbank Ln) or **Salinas Riverwalk** (parking lot behind Wendy's) from **9:00 AM to 12:00 PM**. Participants will help collect litter, debris, and other pollutants, preventing them from entering vital waterways. Supplies including gloves, bags, and water will be provided. Volunteers are encouraged to wear comfortable clothing, sturdy shoes, and sun protection.

“Every piece of trash collected makes a difference,” said Kim Porter, Paso Robles, Stormwater Program Manager. “This is a chance for the community to directly protect our river, enhance wildlife habitat, and keep Paso Robles a clean and healthy community.”

The Creeks to Coast Cleanup is part of a statewide effort to safeguard California’s watersheds and oceans. Paso Robles is proud to join hundreds of other communities across the state on this important day of action.

The Salinas River provides important habitat for fish, amphibians, birds, beavers and other wildlife. A healthy water system is an abundant natural resource, but trash and debris can harm and even kill local wildlife. Fall is an important time to remove trash from our creeks before rain from winter storms arrive and wash debris into our oceans. Thus, cleaning our waterways can improve our environment and keep us, our children, and wildlife safe.

On average, approximately 200 volunteers help in the Creeks to Coast Clean-up Day effort and remove nearly 1 ton of trash and debris. Collecting litter, mattresses, lawnmowers, shopping carts, and tires among other items.

- **Where:** Larry Moore Park (155 Riverbank Ln) & Salinas Riverwalk (parking lot behind Wendy's)

- **Provided:** Gloves, trash bags, water
- **Bring:** Durable shoes, sun protection, reusable water bottle


