City to Begin Annual Westside Fiberized Slurry Project

PASO ROBLES, CA — The City of Paso Robles will begin street improvements to segments of the City’s west side neighborhoods starting the week of January 19, 2026, with the first phase of completion by early February.

Papich Construction will begin installing concrete improvements at Maple and Pacific, followed by 8th and Olive, 9th and Olive, and then the north side of 13th Street between Vine and Spring Street, which will address drainage issues. Traffic control signs and no parking signs will be placed throughout these areas during construction.

The project will be implemented in phases, starting with concrete improvements concluded by early February. Dig-out repairs will also be performed at localized areas prior to placement of the fiberized slurry seal, which will be scheduled at a later date.
