City Park Playground Closure and Beehive Removal

PASO ROBLES, CA — The City of Paso Robles will be removing a beehive located on the north side of the Carnegie Library in downtown City Park on Wednesday, April 15th.

The proximity of the hive and the removal work to both the playground and the Carnegie Library will necessitate a closed work perimeter that encompasses both areas.

The removal is being performed by a highly qualified beekeeper in conjunction with City staff. The hive will be relocated to a safe space away from the public.

Work will commence in the morning and is expected to last approximately 4-5 hours. Out of concern for public safety, the playground and the surrounding area around the Carnegie Library will remain closed for the rest of the day to allow any remaining bees to disperse.

The City recognizes the importance of the natural environment, including local plants and animals, and has carefully evaluated the best course of action for this beehive removal. Safety of park visitors and the community remains the primary concern, and removal will be conducted following best practices.

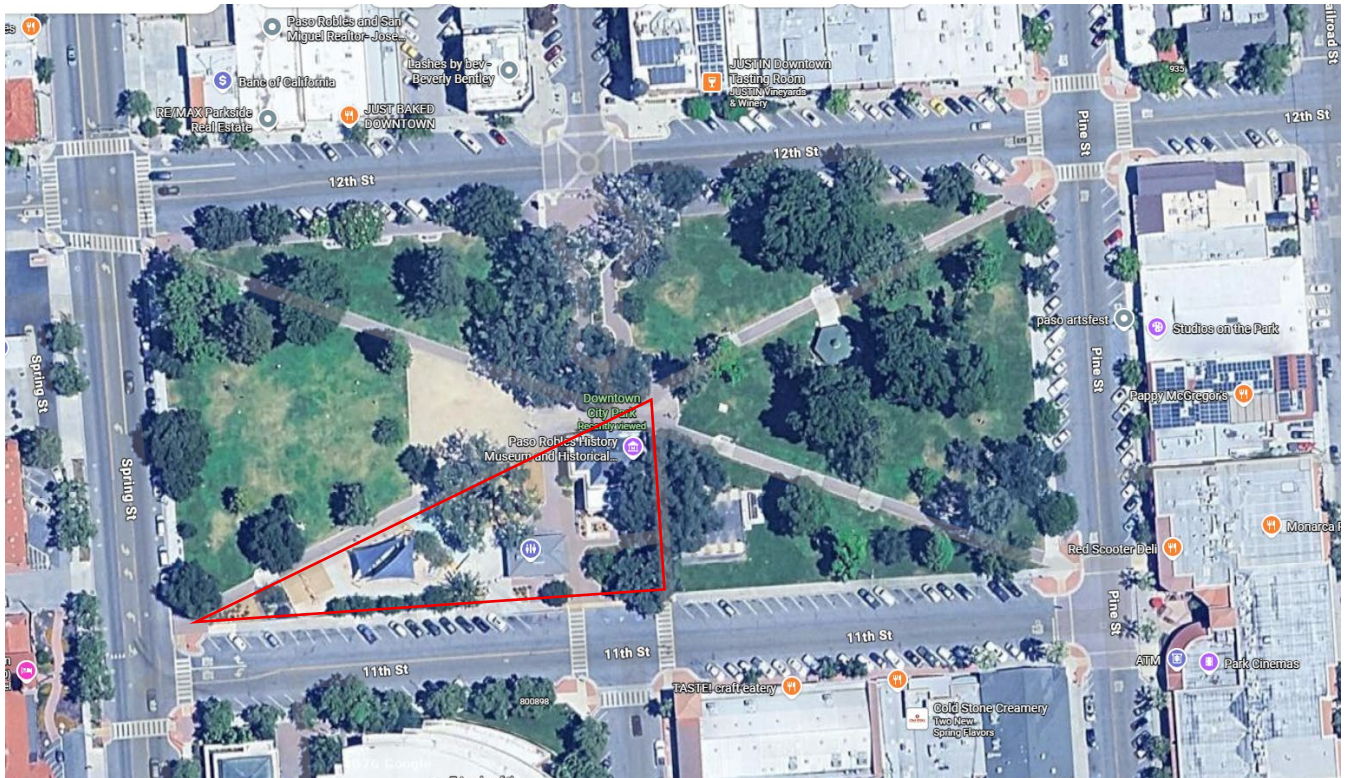


Figure 1 Closure Area for Beehive Removal
