City of Paso Robles Invites Community Input on Proposed North River Road Multiuse Trail

PASO ROBLES, CA – The City of Paso Robles is inviting residents, commuters, students, and trail users to participate in two upcoming community outreach events focused on the proposed North River Road Multiuse Trail project.

The proposed Class I multiuse trail would improve safety, accessibility, and connectivity for people walking, biking, and rolling along the North River Road corridor. Community feedback gathered during these outreach events will help shape future trail design and support ongoing grant funding efforts.

The North River Road segment is also a key piece of the City’s long-term “Grand Loop” vision — a planned network of connected trails, sidewalks, bike facilities, and recreational corridors intended to create safer and more accessible active transportation routes throughout Paso Robles. Completion of this segment would help close a critical gap in the broader loop system and improve connectivity between neighborhoods, schools, parks, and destinations across the community.
