SUBJECT: **Interested in Helping Your Community - Consider Serving on the Templeton CSD Board of Directors**

The Templeton Community Services District is an independent government agency that provides Water, Sewer, Fire and Emergency Services, Solid Waste, Parks and Recreation as well as limited drainage and street lighting services for about 8,000 residents. Board Members serve an important role in how these services are provided by establishing policies, defining priorities, setting utility rates, and ensuring tax dollars are spent efficiently and effectively.

The Board of Directors is made up of five persons, serving staggered four-year terms, and meets once a month on the third Tuesday at 6:30 pm. Board Members also serve on Committees and may represent the District on other regional agencies or commissions. Board Members earn \$150 per day while attending meetings or training, up to a maximum of \$600 per month.

Effective Board Members do not need to have expertise or even experience with the services the District provides, but do need to be able to put in the time necessary to come up to speed with the issues the District is facing, spend a few hours before each meeting reviewing materials and preparing for the meeting, and be able to work with the other members of the Board, District staff and the Community to provide for the best outcomes for the District and its residents and businesses.

The District will have two seats on the Board in the November election and is looking for interested persons to fulfill these important roles. The only requirements for these positions are that the individual be a registered voter and reside within the District's boundaries. These will be four-year terms beginning in December 2026.

The nomination period to file declaration of candidacy forms for the November 3, 2026 Election is from July 13, 2026 through August 7, 2026. Interested candidates

need to call (805) 781-5228 to make an appointment with the County of San Luis Elections Office to take out nomination papers.
