## **Paso Robles Community Services Department Encourages Residents to Apply for Open Board and Advisory Body Positions**

April 1, 2026, Paso Robles, CA – The Paso Robles Community Services Department has a variety of available positions for the Library Board of Trustees, the Youth Commission, the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee, and the Arts and Culture Board. These Boards and Advisory Bodies have been established by the City Council to aid in the gathering of public input, with members serving two- to three-year terms that begin on July 1 of each year. [Applications](#) for the advisory bodies are due to the City on Thursday, April 30, 2026 by 5:00 p.m. with interviews tentatively scheduled to happen on either Wednesday, May 13, 2026 or Thursday, May 14, 2026. “The City’s Boards and Advisory Bodies provide Paso Robles residents with a meaningful way to contribute to their community and help shape its future,” said Angelica Fortin, Director of Community Services for the City of Paso Robles. “We encourage community members who are passionate about making a difference to apply and get involved in these important committees.”

New in 2026, the **Arts and Culture Board** advises on matters pertaining to visual art in public places within city owned or city-controlled leased areas. This board will help shape the future of public art in Paso Robles by determining art placement locations, reviewing submissions, and selecting qualifying artworks for installation. The five-member board will meet quarterly and as needed based on project timelines. The new positions will be staggered with one partial-term position for one year, two partial-term positions for two years and two full-term positions for three years.

The City **Library Board of Trustees** advises on matters concerning the library, assists in the development of library policies, makes recommendations regarding library programs and services, and provides valuable feedback relating to community library needs. The board meets in-person on the second Thursday of the month at 9:00 a.m. There are two full-term positions for three years and one partial-term position for one year available on this board.

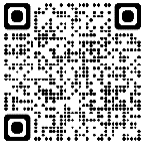

The **Youth Commission** is a youth-led organization that seeks to provide opportunities and representation for youth through collaboration with local government to enrich the lives of youth in the Paso Robles community. The commission meets in-person on the first Wednesday of each month at 5:00 p.m. Members must be between the ages of 14 to 21. There are six positions available on the Youth Commission, five full two-year terms and a partial one-year term.

The **Senior Citizen Advisory Committee** makes recommendations regarding issues of interest to senior citizens. The advisory committee meets in-person on the second Monday of the month at 1:30 p.m. The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee has one open position for a full three-year term.
