DAYTIME ONE-WAY REVERSING TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR HIGHWAY 41 SHOULDER WORK WILL CONTINUE FOR TWO MORE WEEKS

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY — Travelers will encounter daytime one-way reversing traffic control on Highway 41 between Atascadero and Morro Bay for two more weeks.

Shoulder backing work began Monday, September 21 and is being extended through **Friday, October 9.**

Drivers can expect traffic control with a flagger and pilot car from 9 am to 3 pm on Highway 41 from Los Altos Rd. in Atascadero to Bear Ridge Rd. in Morro Bay. Crews are performing shoulder backing work which creates a smooth, level surface along the shoulder that allows drivers to safely steer back onto the highway.

Message and directional signs will alert travelers in advance of the areas under traffic control. Travelers may experience delays of up to 15 minutes.
