A New Stage for Winter Sounds: PRHS Ensembles to Perform Winter Concert at Templeton Performing Arts Center

Paso Robles, CA—The Paso Robles High School Music Department proudly presents its annual Winter Concert, featuring the PRHS Forte Choir, Jazz and Concert Bands, the Crimson Collective Singers, and special guest Bold as Brass quintet, on Thursday, December 18, 2025, at the Templeton Performing Arts Center (TPAC). This year marks the program's first performance at TPAC—a premier North County venue known for its exceptional acoustics and spacious stage, providing an ideal setting for the growing PRHS ensembles.

Under the direction of Gaylene Ewing (choir) and Humberto Cera (band), students will present a festive program celebrating the season through an eclectic mix of music. Audiences will enjoy selections such as *"California Dreamin'," "White Winter Hymnal,"* and holiday favorites including *"Winter Wonderland," "Carol of the Bells,"* and a lively *"Pop Sing-Along."* Expect an evening of bright harmonies, joyful rhythms, and music that captures the spirit of winter.

The PRHS Jazz and Concert Bands, directed by Cera, feature musicians in grades 9–12 representing a range of musical experience. The Forte Choir, directed by Ewing, is PRHS's performance choir, with membership determined by annual audition. The Crimson Collective Singers are a small, advanced audition-based vocal ensemble known for their precision and expressive style.
