C234 Intermediate Firing

San Luis Obispo County - Tentatively, at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, May 15, through Friday, May 17, 2024, CAL FIRE/ San Luis Obispo County Fire Department and CAL FIRE San Benito-Monterey- Monterey Unit personnel will be conducting a hazard reduction burn/C234 Class. This course is cooperatively hosted by CAL FIRE and Camp Roberts Fire Department and allows for crucial training of fire personnel in the art of "fighting fire with fire." Approximately 250 acres will be burned giving students ample learning opportunities and providing an important fuel break at the southeastern boundary of Camp Roberts. Burning is expected to conclude by 5:00 PM each day for 3 days. The burn is being done in cooperation with Camp Roberts Fire Department, Monterey Bay Air Resources District and SLO County APCD, the National Weather Service, and the California Air Resources Board. Smoke may be visible in the northern portions of San Luis Obispo County residents.
