Free Chipping Days Available for Eligible Paso Robles Residents

PASO ROBLES, CA — Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services is encouraging eligible residents to take advantage of Free Chipping Days offered by the San Luis Obispo Fire Safe Council on September 7–9, 2026. Holding this event after Labor Day provides residents with extra time over the three-day holiday weekend to clean up their properties, creating more defensible space and improving wildfire resilience.

The program helps residents reduce wildfire risk by disposing of tree limbs, brush, and other vegetation generated through defensible space and vegetation management projects.

To participate, residents must:

- Be located within the High Fire Hazard Severity Zone in Paso Robles.
- Register online in advance at www.chipperday.com/slofsc.
- Complete their reservation no later than September 8, 2026.

Appointments are required.

Reducing excess vegetation around homes is one of the most effective ways residents can help protect their property and improve community wildfire resilience. Properly maintained defensible space helps firefighters safely defend homes during a wildfire while reducing the potential for fire spread.
