KPRL's Owner/Manager attended the Mid State Fair in Paso Robles, participating in purchasing 4H and FFA (Future Farmers of America) livestock projects at the local Mid State Fair on July 28, 2018. After the event, answering questions about radio broadcasting and employment opportunities.

Sponsored events in the community designed to inform and educate the public as to employment opportunities in broadcasting.

The station also promoted and participated in the August 25, 2018 Made in the Shade fundraiser for the Uptown Park. The September 2018 Pioneer Day committee's auction dinner as host. The Pioneer Day committee raises funds to preserve the local historical museum. KPRL participated in the Templeton 4th of July Celebration Parade, with the News Director as the announcer. KPRL participated in the Colony Days parade in Atascadero on October 6, 2018, with the owner and Sound Off host as the announcers.
