## **City of Paso Robles Invites Senior Residents to Complete Survey Regarding Local Services**

***Paso Robles Community Services Department and  
Senior Citizen Advisory Committee Seek Input Through February 12, 2026***

PASO ROBLES, CA – The City of Paso Robles Community Services Department in conjunction with the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee (SCAC) is launching a 30-day survey of senior residents about the services and programs offered at the Paso Robles Senior Center, the City Library, Paso Robles Recreation Services and the Veterans Memorial Building.

This easy to complete survey lists services and programs offered by these entities related to education, meals, transportation, mental health, financial assistance, health care, recreation, arts and crafts, entertainment, fellowship and volunteer opportunities. The survey is available in English and Spanish. The survey form is available at four locations including the Paso Robles Senior Center (270 Scott Street), Vets Center (240 Scott Street), City Library (1000 Spring Street) and Centennial Park (600 Nickerson Drive). The survey period concludes on Thursday, February 12, 2026.
