PRJUSD Offers Free Summer Childcare for Enrolled Families

Paso Robles, Calif. — Paso Robles Joint Unified School District (PRJUSD) is continuing its commitment to supporting local families by offering free summer childcare programs for students in Transitional Kindergarten through middle school.

Through the District's Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP), families with children in TK through 6th grade have access to full-day summer care at no cost. The program provides a safe, engaging environment where students can participate in enrichment activities, recreation, and continued learning throughout the summer months.

Summer ELOP childcare will run from June 15 through July 28, with closures on June 19 and July 3. Program hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday, offering working families reliable, full-day support.

ELOP Summer Care programs will be hosted at Winifred Pifer Elementary School, Glen Speck Elementary School, and Virginia Peterson Elementary School.

At the time of this release, approximately 550 spots remain available, with enrollment continuing on a first-come, first-served basis.

In addition, PRJUSD is partnering with the Boys & Girls Club of North San Luis Obispo County to provide free summer childcare for students in TK through 8th grade at the Tom Maas Clubhouse, expanding access for older students and offering another high-quality option for families. Summer care at the Boys & Girls Club will run from June 15 - July 31, with closures on June 19 and July 3. Program hours are 7:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Monday - Friday.

Together, these programs reflect PRJUSD's broader effort to remove barriers for families by providing accessible childcare, supporting student well-being, and helping students stay active and connected during the summer.
