Juvenile Arrest at Liberty High School

PASO ROBLES, CA – On 10/10/2024 at approximately 0950 hours, a Paso Robles Police Department School Resource Officer (SRO) was requested at Liberty High School regarding reports of a juvenile who displayed a knife in the parking lot on campus. Additionally, a small group of students confronted one another in the parking lot prompting a report of the potential for physical physical escalation. The Principal was able to narrow the information down to two possible students. Per school policy and school request, a pat down search for weapons was conducted on both students as a precautionary measure. One of the students had a silver, folding pocket knife in his pocket.

The 17 year old male was arrested for 626.10 PC – Possession of a Weapon on School Grounds. He was cooperative with the investigation and transported to San Luis Obispo Juvenile Hall.
