PASO ROBLES JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DEDICATES THREE FACILITIES AT PASO ROBLES HIGH SCHOOL TO LOCAL HONOREES ON THURSDAY, April 25, 2024, 5:00 PM

[Paso Robles, CA, April 23, 2024] On Thursday, April 25, at 5:00 p.m., the Paso Robles Joint Unified School District will honor three of its own with facilities dedicated in their name. The event will begin with a short presentation, including speakers for each honoree, sharing the life and careers of Mr. Ivan Huff, Mr. Greig Welch, and Mr. Tim Alvord.

Please join the District Board of Trustees, administration, staff, friends, and families at the Paso Robles High School Performing Arts Center for a short program and self-guided tour of the newly dedicated facilities. Below are our honorees:

As an athlete, coach, employee, and community member for over 50 years, Ivan Huff has demonstrated pride and dedication to our school district and community. A 1977 graduate of PRHS, Huff earned seven varsity letters, four in cross country and three in track, and holds the school record in the mile and two-mile. At Cal Poly, he subsequently was a member of three national championship teams and part of the 1984, 1988, and 1992 U.S. Olympic Trials in the steeplechase, where he placed fifth in 1984 and, in 1988, placed sixth. He was once ranked 10th in the world in steeplechase as well. His individual accolades are tremendously admirable, but his over three decades of coaching are what truly sets him apart as an impressive and impactful human being. He has changed the lives of hundreds of Paso Robles athletes. He has coached multiple generations of Bearcats and has done so with dignity and a commitment to excellence that is unparalleled.

The Paso Robles High School Track will be named for Ivan Huff.

Greig Welch was a PRJUSD Administrator, Coach, and Educator from 1977-2011. He was born and raised in the area. His utmost wish was to come home to Paso Robles after graduating from Chico State to teach, coach, and help PRJUSD grow. Often, he was the first one on campus and the last one to leave. Greig led by example. His kindness, strength, and support have encouraged many others to do the same. At every level of his career, he was beloved. At PRHS, he was instrumental in promoting the SkillsUSA

program, which has now grown to be a strong part of the High School, with many students winning multiple awards, scholarships, and full careers when they graduate.

The Paso Robles High School (Quad Area) Campus will be named for Greig Welch.

Tim Alvord has been a dedicated member of the Paso Robles community for decades by volunteering his time and effort for numerous fundraisers and programs. He proudly supports youth sports, having served multiple generations of Roblans as a teacher and coach mentor. In the late 1980s, he built a baseball cage where he continues to provide lessons to students and grandchildren. He was also named as Roblan of the Month for May 2021. In 1979, he began teaching at Paso Robles High School (During that time, Alvord coached Varsity Baseball, Varsity Football, JV Football, and Girls Basketball.) He continues to dedicate hours each week to learning new football plays, reviewing films, and talking with other coaches to make sure the players are taught well each year and teams are equipped and ready to compete.

The Boy’s PE Facility will be named for Tim Alvord.
