City of Paso Robles Announces July 4th Event Entertainment Lineup

PASO ROBLES, CA – The City of Paso Robles, in partnership with Travel Paso, is excited to announce the entertainment lineup for this year's beloved July 4th celebration at Barney Schwartz Park. Along with the Fun Zone and a variety of food trucks, guests can look forward to an evening of live music, a meaningful community ceremony, and a spectacular fireworks finale.

The evening's entertainment will kick off at 5:30 p.m. with *Garden Party*, a talented group of seasoned local musicians performing favorite classics from the '60s and '70s. Guests can enjoy familiar songs inspired by artists such as Steely Dan, America, and James Taylor.

At 7:15 p.m., the Central Coast's favorite dance band, *Steppin' Out*, will take the stage with a high-energy set of danceable hits from artists including Bruno Mars, Selena, and Earth, Wind & Fire.

Immediately following the live musical performances, community members will be invited to take part in a special patriotic tribute. The ceremony will feature a unified joint Presentation of Colors by the North County Veterans Color Guard, comprised of members from Paso Robles American Legion Post 50, Paso Robles VFW Post 10965, Templeton American Legion Post 220, Atascadero VFW Post 2814, and active-duty soldiers from United States Army Signal Activity Camp Roberts.

Following the Presentation of Colors, the crowd will be invited to stand for a stirring live performance of the National Anthem by rising country artist and Shandon native, *Callie Twisselman*. This special ceremony will serve as the official prelude to the evening's fireworks show.

"We wanted to create a moment of unity and gratitude before the celebration in the sky begins," said Lynda Plescia, event coordinator. "Bringing these veteran groups together on stage, followed by a live performance of the National Anthem, will be an unforgettable highlight of the night."
