This is a nonpartisan event for all registered voters in District 2 and those who want to help with the recall effort. The Committee to Support the Recall of Supervisor Bruce Gibson is having a petition-signing event on Sunday, January 14th at Atascadero Lake Park from 12 to 4:00pm. It will be at the covered picnic area closest to the zoo. For the first 300 there will be free hot dogs, chili, and chips! Hot chocolate will be available too.

It's a call to action and an opportunity for the community to come together who believe our elected officials should represent "we the people" instead of abusing their power.

There is a growing group of citizens who have had enough of Supervisor Gibson, who is not representing the people but is actively implementing his own agenda. With multiple Brown Act violations last year, his arrogant attitude and name-calling of constituents who don't agree with his policies, Gibson has gone too far.

Supervisor Gibson publicly stated recently of the importance of raising our taxes and that he is in favor of gutting Proposition 13, which would financially impact every person who lives in our county.

Who is eligible to sign the petition? All registered voters from District 2 as defined by the Patten map, those who had Bruce Gibson on their ballot in the 2022 elections are eligible. This area includes the city of Atascadero, rural West Templeton, rural West Paso Robles, San Miguel Community Services District, Lake Nacimiento, Oak Shores, Heritage Ranch, and the coastal communities of San Simeon, Cambria and Cayucos.
