Multi-family Structure Fire

PASO ROBLES, CA – On Wednesday August 19, 2026 at approximately 1:56 PM Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services responded to a report of a structure fire at 324 Vine Street.

First arriving firefighters found light smoke showing from a raised foundation duplex at 522 4th Street. The fire started on an outside deck and spread into nearby vegetation. One unit was occupied at the time and firefighters assisted the resident and her dog out into the street. Firefighters contained the fire to the deck and exterior of the building with no extension into the attic.

One fire engine, one truck, one squad and one Battalion Chief from Paso Robles responded. Under the City's automatic aid agreements, one fire engine and one Battalion Chief from Cal Fire / SLO County. A total of 12 firefighters responded to the incident with additional assistance from both Paso Robles Police Department and San Luis Ambulance Service.

The cause of the fire was determined to be smoking related.

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
