Residential Structure Fire

PASO ROBLES, CA – On Wednesday August 12th, 2026, at approximately 4:55 PM Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services responded to a report of a residential structure fire in the 1200 block of Dorothy Street in Paso Robles.

First arriving firefighters found smoke and fire inside the bathroom of a single story, single family residential structure. Firefighters were able to stop the fire to the room of origin and limit extension into the attic and living space. Firefighters worked to prevent smoke and water damage to the occupant's belongings and remainder of the structure.

The residence was unoccupied at the time of the fire, and the owners were notified by Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services personnel. No injuries were reported for this incident.

Three Fire Engines, one Squad, two Fire Investigators, one Training Officer, and one Battalion Chief from Paso Robles responded. Under the City's automatic aid agreements, one Fire Engine and one Battalion Chief from Cal Fire / SLO County Fire responded to assist. A total of 19 firefighters responded to the incident with additional assistance from both Paso Robles Police Department and San Luis Ambulance Service.

Paso Robles Fire Investigators determined the fire was caused by an electric exhaust fan. Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services would like to remind all residents to ensure they have working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in their residence.

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
