## **Vandalism at the Paso Robles High School**

*Paso Robles, CA (August 10, 2023)* – The Paso Robles Joint Unified School District reports that the Paso Robles High School was broken into and vandalized during today's early morning hours.

The Paso Robles Police Department was dispatched after they received an alarm call from the Paso Robles High School. The activated alarms came from multiple rooms throughout campus. Upon officers arriving, they found juveniles who ran from an alarm-activated classroom. Two juveniles were detained. A hammer and a fire extinguisher were found in one of the juvenile possessions. During the police investigation, it was discovered that multiple classrooms had broken windows, and damaged school property was located across the campus. School property damage is estimated to run from \$30,000 to over \$100,000.

The two arrested juveniles are currently in custody with the juvenile authorities.

The PRHS Staff and District officials will continue collaborating with the local police department as the investigation continues.
